

## *Féile na Cásca / Easter Art Exhibition 2011*

**Halla Cheann Trá (Ventry Hall), 24 April – 1 May**

Féile na Cásca, the longest running Art Exhibition in West Kerry (30+ years!), has survived past recessions and will also battle this one out. Art from over eighty local and visiting artists will be on show as well as works from pupils from all the local primary schools. Some of the better-known artists whose work can be seen are Maria Simonds-Gooding, Tomás Ó Cíobháin and Liam Ó Néill.



This year, banners and flags representing the Celtic countries will be made by the young people in the local primary schools, as once again this year the Pan Celtic Festival will be held in Corca Dhuibhne. The exhibition will run from Easter Sunday until 1 May.
